

CORRECTIONS

Angiotensin-Receptor Blockade versus Converting-Enzyme Inhibition in Type 2 Diabetes and Nephropathy (November 4, 2004; 351:1952-61). On page 1952, in the Abstract, the first sentence of the Results section should have stated (with revised numbers in bold): "After five years, the change in the glomerular filtration rate was **-17.5** ml per minute per 1.73 m² of body-surface area, where the minus sign denotes a decrement, with telmisartan (in 103 subjects), as compared with **-15.0** ml per minute per 1.73 m² with enalapril (in 113 subjects), for a treatment difference of **-2.6** ml per minute per 1.73 m² (95 percent confidence interval, **-7.1 to 2.0** ml per minute per 1.73 m²)."

Also, on page 1957, in the left-hand column, lines 18 through 26 of the first full paragraph should have read (with revised numbers in bold): "After five years, the mean change in the glomerular filtration rate was **-17.5** ml per minute per 1.73 m² (where the minus sign denotes a decrement) in the telmisartan-treated subjects, as compared with **-15.0** ml per minute per 1.73 m² in the enalapril-treated subjects; the treatment difference was thus **-2.6** ml per minute per 1.73 m² (95 percent confidence interval, **-7.1 to 2.0** ml per minute per 1.73 m²)."

Bell's Palsy (January 27, 2005;352:416-8). Line 3 of the letter by Djalilian should have referred to "neurotologists," rather than "neurologists," as printed.

The Unturned Stone (February 3, 2005;352:489-94). On page 492, the histologic specimens shown in Figures 2 and 3 were from the distal ileum, not from the colon, as indicated in the legend for Figure 2. Colonic biopsy specimens showed similarly ulcerated mucosa, with macrophages containing *Histoplasma capsulatum*.
